Our Farm:

Green Earth Harvest, a program of The Conservation Foundation, is a non-profit, organic vegetable farm which feeds over 1,000 families through our 28-week farmshare program, farm stands, and 6 local food pantries. We've sustainably farmed for over 20 years on the 60-acres of protected land at McDonald Farm, the headquarters of The Conservation Foundation, located in Naperville, IL.

Natural resource conservation, improving the health of our community, providing a safe work environment, and equitable compensation for our farmers are at the core of all that we do.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Helping to load produce for deliveries
- Safely navigating to delivery sites for unloading and picking up empty delivery bins from previous weeks.
- Clearly communicating with the Farm Manager and/or Business Manager if there are delays or problems
- · Keeping on schedule
- Unloading empty used bins upon return from deliveries

Successful Candidates Are:

- In good physical condition, comfortable lifting bins that can weigh over 40 lbs.
- Reliable
- Comfortable driving safely in all weather conditions.
- Good at remaining on schedule
- Personable, as deliveries require some personal interaction with clients
- In Possession of a Valid Driver's License

Work Schedule:

- Seasonal, Part-Time: May 23, 2024 November 27, 2024
- Thursdays- 8:30am approximately 4:00pm: Home deliveries, and satellite delivery
- Fridays: 9:00-11:00am: Food pantry Delivery to Itasca
- Tuesday: November 26 for home/satellite delivery (Thanksgiving schedule)

- Farm-fresh, organic vegetables! Crew members are highly encouraged to bring home and enjoy the vegetables we grow.
